Major Similarities and Differences

Organization

Village	Schools
<p>Procedure Committee: Administers Citizens Nominating Committee (CNC) election and Reviews/ Proposes Amendments to the Resolution</p> <p>CNC: Selects single slate of nominees for Village office</p> <p>Citizens’ Non-Partisan Campaign Committee: Standing committee authorized by the TVCC to conduct campaign for nominees of the CNC</p>	<p>Joint Committee: Reviews/Proposes Amendments to the Resolution</p> <p>Administrative Committee: Administers School Board Nominating Committee (SBNC) election</p> <p>SBNC: Selects single slate of nominees for the Board of Education</p> <p>Campaign Committee: None</p>

Composition of Committees

Village	Schools
<p>Procedure Committee: 23 members – 11 appointed by TVCC (chair + 10, of which one of 10 is vice chair); 2 appointed by SNAP; and 10 most recently retired voting members of CNC</p> <p>CNC: 30 voting members, 6 from each elementary attendance area elected to staggered, three-year terms; 4 non-voting members consisting of the chair, vice chair and 1 representative each from the TVCC and SNAP</p> <p>Citizens’ Non-Partisan Campaign Committee: No fixed number. Membership is voluntary</p>	<p>Joint Committee: 27 members – chair and vice chair of SBNC (2); members of the outgoing Administrative Committee, including the chair, vice chair and three appointed members (15); most recently retired SBNC voting members (10)</p> <p>Administrative Committee: 21 members – chair and vice chair (2); 10 most recently retired voting members of the SBNC (10); and three members each appointed to three-year staggered terms by the TVCC, SNAP and at-large by the chair (9)</p> <p>SBNC: 30 voting members, 6 from each elementary attendance area elected to staggered, three-year terms; 4 non-voting members consisting of chair, vice chair and 1 representative each from the TVCC and SNAP</p>

Selection of Chair and Vice Chair

Village	Schools
<p>Procedure Committee: Appointed by TVCC</p> <p>CNC: President of TVCC serves as chair; first vice president of TVCC is vice chair</p> <p>Citizens' Non-Partisan Campaign: First vp of TVCC serves as chair</p>	<p>Joint Committee: Outgoing chair of Administrative Committee</p> <p>Administrative Committee: Vice chair ascends to chair in following year. Joint Committee appoints vice chair</p> <p>SBNC: Elected by voting members of SBNC from outgoing class or a previously retired class</p>

Financing

Village	Schools
<p>Procedure Committee: Public solicitation; TVCC acts as 'lender' when needed</p> <p>CNC: Not codified</p> <p>Campaign Committee: Public solicitation</p>	<p>Administrative Committee: Public solicitation. Resolution authorizes funding by Administrative Committee for Joint Committee and SBNC expenses</p>
